

PGYVC KODIAK COACHING DURATION POLICY

September 20, 2026

This policy was created to give athletes an opportunity to play for multiple coaches during their club volleyball careers.

Item 1: Kodiak Head Coaches may not coach with the same group for more than three (3) consecutive club volleyball seasons.

- For example: a head coach may apply to stay with the same team for 12U, 13U and 14U. After that team's 14U season, there will be a new head coach for that group's 15U season.
- Coaches switching roles is not considered a coaching change (head coaches becoming assistant coaches, assistant coaches becoming head coaches).

Item 2: Kodiak Assistant Coaches may not coach with the same group for more than three (3) club volleyball seasons.

- For example: an assistant coach may apply to stay with the same team for 13U, 14U and 15U. After the 15U season, there will be a new head coach for that group's 16U season.
- Coaches switching roles is not considered a coaching change (head coaches becoming assistant coaches, assistant coaches becoming head coaches).

Item 3: There will be a mandatory change in coaching staff, regardless of how many seasons the coaches have been with the group following that group's 16U season.

- For example: if a coaching staff starts with a team in their 15U season, then stays with them for their 16U season, they may not coach that group at 17U.
- Coaches switching roles is not considered a coaching change (head coaches becoming assistant coaches, assistant coaches becoming head coaches).
